Tunis (CERTE) status water saving kits distributions

Purchase 6000 water saving kits (2,5 Euro/Kit, 15MEuros), to be freely distributed to citizens and visitors of SWM houses. The kit will be composed by 2 low consumption taps and one flow reducer for the shower and one information leaflet in the local language: (expected 35 Euro/Kit, 430 Kits)

-1- Secondary school of ZEM and neighborhood (about 200 Kits), Kits will be adapted to the specific needs. Ministry of education will be in charge of the installation at the secondary school, they will also monitor the water consumption before and after and maintains the equipment.

Continue Tunis (CERTE) status water saving kits distributions

-2- Primary school of ZEM (about 10 Kits), Kits will be adapted to the specific needs. Ministry of education will renovate all the sanitary area and install the received kits. they will also monitor the water consumption before and after. and maintains the equipment.

-3- Bardo Center (selected apartments, about 10 apparatus and more if there is an interest of implementation and monitoring) mainly aerators and flow reducer, Chorfech zone (about 40), SWM house (TDC) for training, demonstration, awareness (about 200 Kits)

Palestine (PWA) status Water Saving Kits distributions

- ✓ **FIRST PHASE: DISTRIBUTION OF THE WATER SAVING KITS IN PALESTINE (Water saving Kits minimum tap [1420]; Water saving Kits Toilet washer [120]; Water saving Kits bath shower [120])**

Total cost 8280 Euro (Finished on April, 2013)

AREA JINEN WATER COUNCIL, MAYTHOLON AND TUBAS MUNICIPALITIES AND HOUSE TARGETED.

- ✓ **Water saving kits to be freely distributed to citizens. The kit will be composed by low consumption taps and more information leaflet in the local language.**

Palestine (PWA) status Water Saving Kits distributions

- ✓ **SECOND PHASE: DISTRIBUTION WATER SAVING KITS:**
- ✓ Meetings with local stakeholders (administrative and technical officers, professional organizations, consumers' associations).
- ✓ Site-tour in the areas where the kits will be distributed.
- ✓ Fitting parts to be fit and suitable for tap mainly in the schools, universities and public building.
- ✓ (Water saving Kits minimum tap and their fitting parts [500 to public]).
- ✓ Water saving Kits Toilet [120].
- ✓ Water saving Kits shower[120]
- ✓ Total cost 12,000 Euro (July, 2013)
